Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical performance are ineligible to participate.

Preferred classes will run with the corresponding regular classes and height divisions. Exc will run with Master in the corresponding height divisions. Nov A and Nov B will be combined in the running order.

Moving Up To The Next Class

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that request is made IN WRITING (email is fine but texts are not acceptable) and received by 6:00 pm on Monday prior to the trial. These move-ups will be official only when confirmation is received by the requesting party. Move-ups for Sat & Sun will be accommodated, provided the information is received by the Trial Secretary in writing no later than 15 minutes after the close of judging on the day prior to the move-up effective date. Blank move-up forms will be provided at the trial.

Extended Wait List

If the trial fills, a waiting list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial closing date will be maintained. A maximum of 50 runs/day will be placed on the wait list. The waiting list close will be Saturday, May 18, at 5:00 p.m. (CT). All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the trial secretary prior to the closing date of the trial. Full refunds will be given to those exhibitors withdrawing after closing but no later than May 18 at 5 pm **ONLY** for the runs that are able to be filled from the waiting list.

Jump Height Policy

Jump height cards are not required to be submitted with the entry form. The entry form has a check box to indicate if the dog needs to be measured. It is the owner's responsibility to understand the rules, and if the dog needs to be measured, it is the owner's/handler's responsibility to ensure that the box on the entry form is checked, and that the dog is measured prior to running. If you are unsure, contact the trial secretary for assistance.

- Injured dogs that are not able to compete in these Agility Trials are eligible to

Course Familiarization and Warm-Ups

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. The walk-through period allows handlers to plan their strategy for running the course and will be held prior to each class, following the judge's briefing. For classes with large entry numbers, walk-throughs will be split by jump heights.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided.

Prizes & Awards

Rosettes will be awarded for 1st through 4th place teams in each jump height in each class. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores. MACH, PACH and AGCH ribbons will be awarded for those finishing their championship title. Title ribbons will be awarded to those dogs earning a new title at this event.

Entering for Exhibition Only (FEO)

- For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. Participation in FEO is nonqualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es)
 (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the
 Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results
 for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler
 will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an
 ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must
 declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not
 allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.
